Plan Baton Rouge Phase II

The **Central Green** draws its significance from the aggregation of cultural and civic buildings that surround it, including City Hall, the Public Library, the Old State Capitol, the Shaw Center for the Arts, the Louisiana Art and Science Museum, the River Center, the 19th Judicial District Courthouse, and the Theatre for the Performing Arts. The distinct and fragmented grounds of these institutions can be unified by a system of greenspaces including North Boulevard Town Square, Galvez Plaza, Repentance Park and the final component - the redesign of City Hall Plaza.

City Hall Plaza

The redesign of City Hall Plaza will involve the removal of underutilized and harsh existing hardscapes in the plaza, replacing them with a large green lawn and shade trees. The redesign will provide better circulation throughout the City Hall and River Center Campuses, and allow the Galvez Stage to be used from both sides by covering the B1 parking lot.
